

## Kitchen Information




- The halal meals are up and running now and if your child has registered they will order as normal on the smartboard in the classroom and the kitchen will know to provide the halal option.
- Anyone entitled to a free meal should have applied by now. Primary 1 to 3 automatically receive a free lunch. Anyone who was primary 3 last year and is entitled to free meals must apply.
- If your child owes any lunch money it should be paid the following day either by paying online or money can be paid into your child's account at the kitchen.
- If your child has any allergies we need a letter from acute services at the Queen Elizabeth hospital and we can cater for your child
- We have a tuck shop at morning break and after lunch everyday for primary 4 and 5 in the junior department and for primary 2,3,6,7 in the main building
