

Dear Parent/Carer,

You will be aware from media coverage that the current intention is on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February, P1-3 pupils will be returning to full time education in schools. *However, this will be confirmed by the Scottish Government on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> February.* 

This letter outlines some key guidelines and practical information regarding your child's return to school similar to our August return.

The appropriate public health measures will be in place:

- Enhanced hand hygiene and cleaning practices
- Caring for children in small groups & minimised social contact between these groups
- Physical distancing between adults in school including parents at drop off and pick up
- Maximising use of outdoor spaces

## **Entry & Exits**

- All pupils must enter by their allocated gate as detailed below
- Parents are not permitted to enter the school grounds or school building at any point during the visit. Thank you for your support with this.
- When the bell rings children will be collected from their line by a member of staff.

Primary	Gate of Entry	Line Location	Door of Entry
P1	Main Gate at Front of School (Left Hand Side)	P1 Playground	P1 Entrance
P2	Lower Gate (from cages)	P2 Playground	P2 Entrance
P3	Main Gate at Front of School (Right Hand Side)	Follow path to right of school office, move through link corridor and line up in P3 Playground	P3 Entrance

## **Lining up Procedure**

When you arrive in the morning we ask that your child lines up outside their designated gate. At 8.50am the gates will be opened by a member of staff. Once your child enters the grounds, they should find their class star and line up behind it following social distancing guidelines.

## **Uniform/Outdoor Clothing**

There will be increased opportunities for our pupils to apply their skills in outdoor contexts and they must ensure that they have **outdoor clothing suitable for all weathers**. This clothing should be brought to school every day and should be clearly labelled with their name and class.

**Water Bottles:** Please ensure your child comes to school with a filled water bottle. There will be limited access to water stations throughout the school day.
