The groups are held annually in a school within East Renfrewshire one evening per week for five weeks.

Parents or carers can attend. The groups all run at the same time, so it is important to get the right age group for you. If you have children within the three areas mentioned then consider the "Primary Group" as this can help to some degree with the early teens.

On the final evening you will be asked to complete an evaluation which will help us to improve the groups we run for parents.











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How do the groups work?

The groups help parents to understand and improve their skills, change family power structures and develop more productive relationships within the family.

Where does the materials for the groups come from?

The materials, designed to provide support at all stages of the family life cycle, have been developed by Family Caring Trust and tested in various social settings. The situations presented in the books and DVDs come out of a variety of different social and ethnic backgrounds. Authors are the husband and wife team, Michael and Terri Quinn, whose books have sold over two million copies worldwide. The groups follow the same themes and cover roughly the same topics.
