<ul> <li>The Pupil Council meeting was opened with the school prayer.</li> <li>1. Departmental Awards</li> <li>Pupils agreed that awards given should not only be academic. They acknowledge that pupil badges were given as recognition in other fields.</li> <li>Pupils discussed possibility of reports being used to give out awards (i.e. if improvement had been shown in two or more subjects.)</li> <li>It was suggested that each department makes a number of nominations at the end of the year. Badges could then be given out at an awards ceremony and if more than a set amount of subjects had nominated a particular pupil then an excellence badge could be awarded.</li> <li>Pupils appreciated the discussion with Mr Docherty at the end of last year when he issued some subject badges.</li> <li>Another form of recognition could be being invited on a trip at the end of the year.</li> </ul>		

## 2. Prelims

- Pupils felt well informed in the lead up to the prelim examinations.
