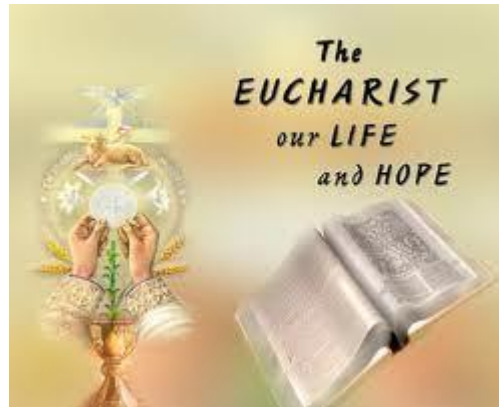


# Over the next few weeks.....

## The Net Team Events.

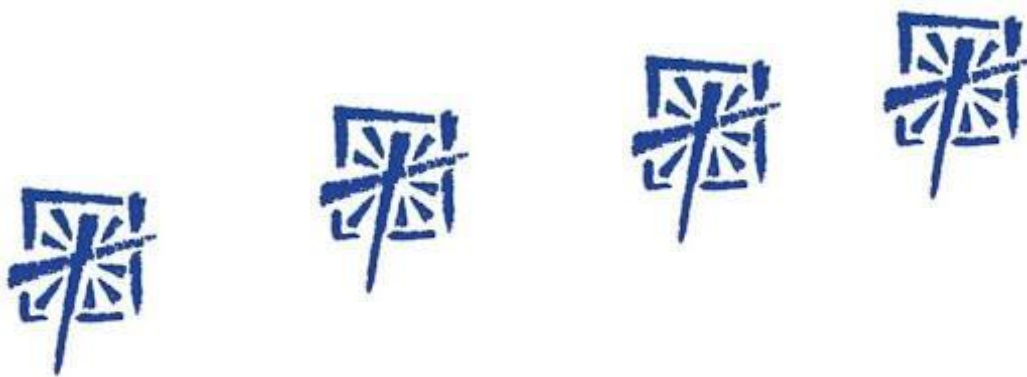
