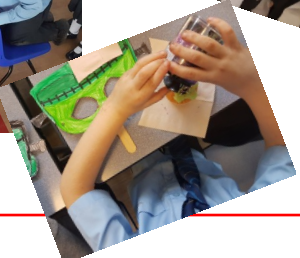
## Halloween Disco

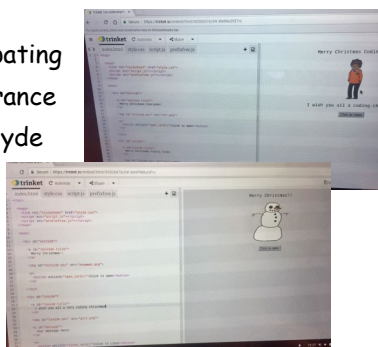
## Inclement Weather
