### Improving St Joseph's!

To ensure the continuous improvement of St Joseph's and the excellent learning and teaching that takes place, School Improvement Priorities are set for each new session. For the session 2018-19 our priorities are:



- 1. Raising attainment in Literacy through:
  - ♦ Reading recovery in P2
  - ◆ Creating a reading culture through developing our school library
  - ◆ Sharing good practice in the teaching of Literacy across the school with a particular focus on engagement.
  - Ensuring consistency of approach to Grammar and Spelling from P1 through to P7.
- 2. Raising attainment in Numeracy through:
  - ♦ Introduction of progression pathways and new planning tool
  - Maths champion to drive effective learning and teaching by sharing good practice from P1 to P7
  - Introduction of SEAL and Number Talks approach to mental maths.
  - ♦ St Ninian's maths teacher to support effective learning, teaching and transitions in P6 and P7.
