FUNDRAISING

Whilst we continue to be unable to offer our usual, well supported, in person social fundraising events due to the pandemic, and as mentioned in our New Year Newsletter, we nevertheless need to continue to try, where possible, to raise funds for our school.

At our last parent council meeting our Head Teacher advised that more chrome books and reading books are required for our children and that our financial support is required to obtain these items, in the current climate of budget cuts.
