We would ask that all guests are seated by 5.50pm.

WHERE DO CHILDREN & SPONSORS GO?

All Candidates and Sponsors must be in the Church by 5.45pm.

Teachers will meet them there, take a register and ensure pupils have their name badges.

Children have been allocated seating positions and their sponsor should sit directly beside them in the reserved rows.

- 7a Right side facing the altar
- 7b Left side facing the altar

All other guests are welcome to sit in the remaining rows behind the reserved rows.

THE LITURGY OF CONFIRMATION

Baptismal Promises

Candidates all stand together to renew their Baptismal Promises, responding "I do."

Anointing with Chrism

Candidates will be invited to come forward with their sponsors

Sponsors should be slightly behind and place their right hand on the right shoulder of the candidate

The Celebrant anoints the candidate saying: Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit

Candidate responds: <u>Amen</u>

Celebrant: Peace be with you

Candidate: <u>And with your spirit</u>

Children and sponsors will return to their original seating positions by the side aisles.

GENERAL REMINDERS

Full school uniform to be worn: grey trousers/skirt (modest length), blue shirt and tie, black shoes, grey socks/tights

No filming or taking of photographs during the service is permitted; you are welcome to do this at the end.
