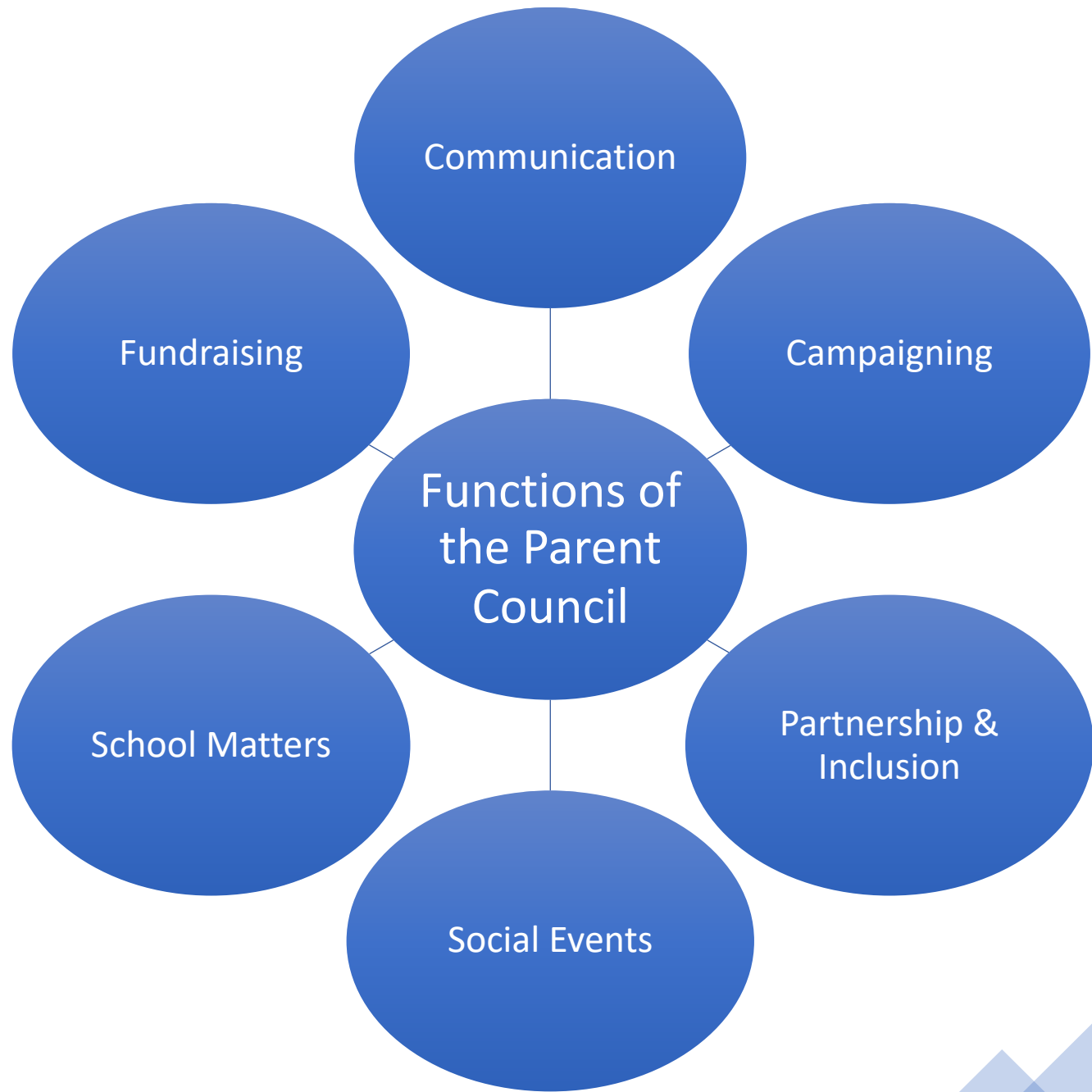

Annual Commitments

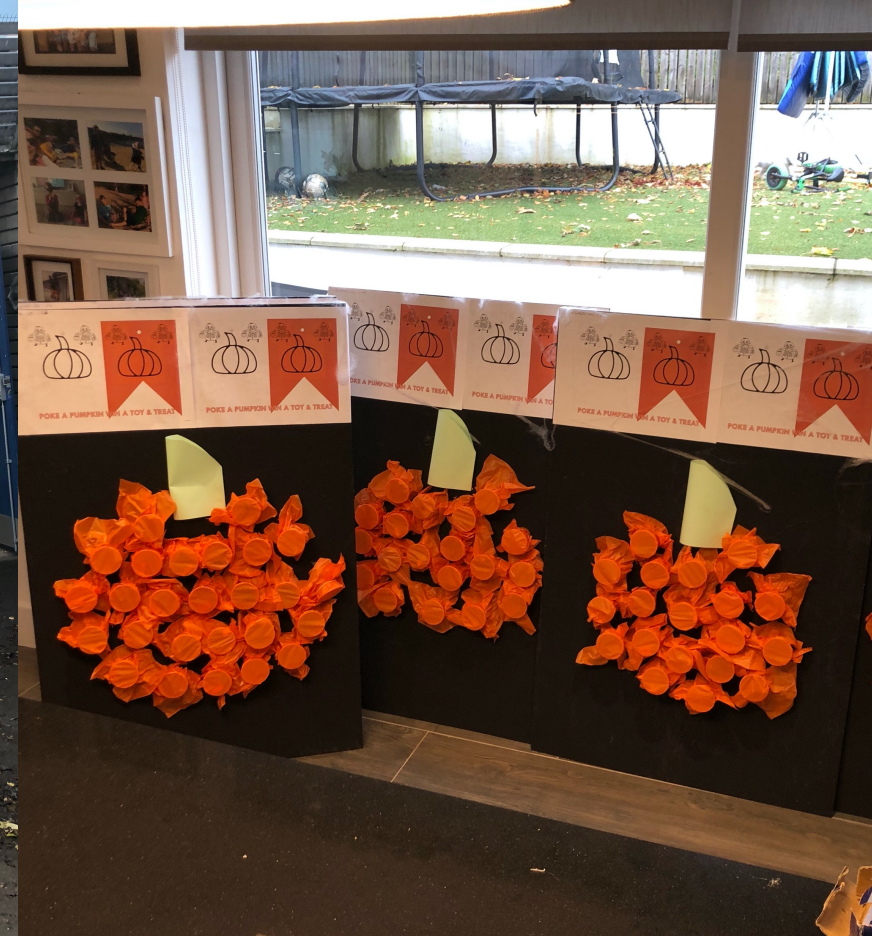
- P1 Welcome Night - Kids Entertainer, refreshments & nibbles for P1 families

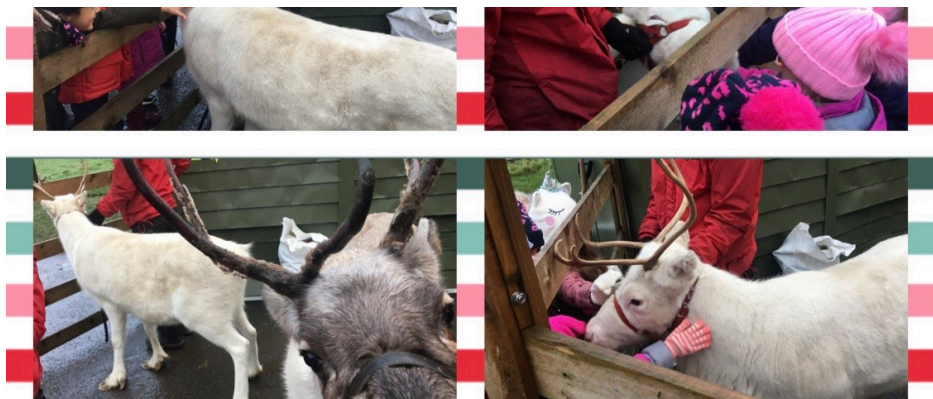

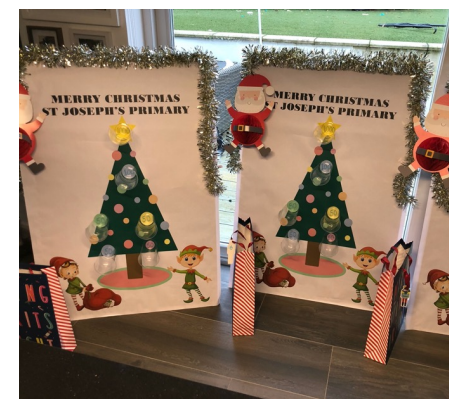

Gym Kit:

Cheaper to purchase via the PC the approved badged T-shirt can only be purchased from our nominated supplier. Navy shorts can be bought anywhere it is sports style baggy shorts that our supplier stock these are not badged. Badged gym bags are available from supplier of via the school office.



Ties:

It is normal that all feeder nursery classes provide a standard school tie at graduation. It is strongly preferred on Muddy Movers days that an elastic tie is worn these can be purchased only from our supplier and is cheaper via the PC. A small amount of ties for emergency situations are available to purchase from the school office throughout the school year.
