Dear P7 Parent/Guardian,

I hope you found the Sacramental Preparation Meeting for parents informative last night.

Although Confirmation isn't until May next year, I thought it might be useful to give a brief outline of key information given from the Diocesan Office well in advance:

WHEN IS CONFIRMATION?

Confirmation for St Joseph's and Our Lady of The Missions pupils will take place on **Thursday 02 May 2024** at 6:30pm in St Mirin's Cathedral, Paisley.

WHO CAN COME?

There are no tickets for entry to the Cathedral however due to the numbers involved, direction from the Diocesan office is that there is a suggested maximum of 5 guests per family (including sponsor).

WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD WEAR?

Full school uniform: grey trousers/skirt of a modest length, blue shirt and St Joseph's tie, grey socks/tights, black school shoes

WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

- We will continue to prepare pupils in school for receiving this Sacrament both spiritually and practically
- We ask that you also continue to support your child at home. e.g. learning prayers, ensuring attendance at Mass, engagement in Pope Francis Faith Award activity and keeping the PFFA Journal, Reconciliation, etc.
- Help your child to decide on a sponsor (baptised, practising Catholic, over 16 years old)
- As clarified by Canon Stephen last night, parents cannot be sponsors. He is able to support via Parish members who would be willing to act as sponsors if required, so please contact him directly, should this be the case.
- **Mass of Commitment for P7 Confirmation Pupils - 9am Sunday 26 November 23 at St Joseph's Church**
