Curriculum Learning	
	Term 1 has a STEM focus: Science/TechnologyEngineering/Maths. We look forward to learning about the Science topic of Genetics with the help of a geneticist (parent, Mrs Jordan) and in Technology, plan to explore DNA by making structural models. <u>What is inheritance? - BBC Bitesize</u> We will also be completing experiments and participating in national online STEM events.
Literacy ABC	This term, we are studying the novel 'Wonder' by R.J. Palacio. <u>Wonder BookTrust</u> and exploring themes such as inclusion/ discrimination. Our learning from the novel also links with our Health and Wellbeing and STEM lessons. In Grammar, we will be exploring homophones (words that sound the same but are spelt differently), parts of speech and definite and indefinite articles (<i>a, an</i> or <i>the</i>).
Numeracy and Maths	This term, we are expanding our knowledge of Fractions, Decimals and Percentages, long multiplication and long division. Please encourage your child to try different strategies when tackling these calculations. For Mental Maths, please encourage your child to use Number Talks strategies such as open number lines or partitioning when completing Mental Maths calculations . <u>Numeracy</u> and Mathematics St Joseph's Primary School
Health and Wellbeing	With our term 1 focus on Mental Health and Emotional Wellbeing, P7 will explore feelings and emotions and will discover things about other people's feelings and emotions. We will also find out about mental health and what it can be like to be a target of stigma or discrimination. We will work on our Physical Health through The Daily Mile and will develop skills in Football, Golf, and Hockey.
Religious Education	As candidates for Confirmation, we will be learning about the Fruits and Gifts of the Holy Spirit and will be required to make regular entries in our PFFA Journals to reflect on how we are using them at home, at school and in our Parish. <u>Sacramental Information St Joseph's Primary School</u>
