P4 Sacramental Information

Dear Primary 4 Parents/Guardians,

P4 Rite of Commitment

Those children who will be receiving their Sacraments in Primary 4 will commit to their Sacramental preparation at an allocated **P4** Mass of Commitment: **10am on Sunday 2nd March 2025** in St. Joseph's Church as stated in our [Holy Dates Calendar](#) sent out in August.

(If this mass is not suitable for family arrangements, they are welcome to attend any other Mass in St Joseph's/St Bridget's during the weekend of Saturday 1st/Sunday 2nd March 2025.)

- The children will continue to discuss their Sacramental journey in class, we ask that you take time to reinforce this at home. The children are completing the 'Diocese of Paisley Sacramental Preparation Booklet'. This home/school journal is a special opportunity for you to help your child during their journey of faith towards receiving these important Sacraments.
- The children will sit with their family and the priest will ask them to come forward to collect an 'Our Father' prayer card. They will then recite the Our Father prayer together and return to their seats.
- The children should wear their **school uniform** when attending the Rite of Commitment.

There will also be an opportunity to attend the '['Laudato Si' Pre-loved Uniform and Communion Clothes Sale](#)' and Coffee Morning in the Church Hall on Sunday 2nd February following 10am Mass.

The children will be participating in their Sacrament of Reconciliation on **Tuesday 4th March 2025** in school. The children will participate in a service, which will be recorded and posted on Google Classroom. The children will then make their First Reconciliation after the service.
