#### General

### Curriculum Learning

#### STEM



This term we have a focus on STEM subjects. In Science, we are developing our skills in identifying and classifying living things, focusing on 'Minibeasts', to help appreciate their diversity. The children have created some 'burning questions' at home which we will use to inform our next steps in learning and to plan together what we will explore in the 'Science Area' in our classrooms. We will also be investigating 'Changing States,' and 'Electrical Circuits' later in the term. We are very excited to use our STEM Room again and will be developing skills in design, engineering and technology using wood work and sewing materials.

#### Literacy



In Literacy, we are continuing to develop our knowledge of phonics using the Jolly Spelling Programme. Please continue to practice reading and writing words with the new spelling rules, which will be posted on Google Classroom each week. In Writing, we are exploring various types of instructions, including recipes, games and craft instructions, to identify their features and use them in our own writing. In Reading, we will be reading non fiction texts, using features of the text (including contents, index pages and glossaries) to help us locate information. At home, pupils could select a non-fiction book from the library so that they can search for information on topics which specifically follow their own interests.

#### Numeracy and Maths



In Numeracy, we are using Number Talks to help us use different strategies to solve problems, such as 'Making Landmarks' and 'Friendly Numbers'. We have been enjoying sharing our strategies with our peers. Ask your child to share some of the strategies they have been learning at home! We are also continuing to improve our rapid recall of multiplication facts and use games such as '[Hit the Button](#)' to set new targets for ourselves. In Maths we are exploring area and estimating and measuring area by counting whole and half centimetre squares.

#### Health and Wellbeing



PE Lessons are on a Monday (P4b) and a Wednesday (P4a). We are developing skills in football and hockey and have also started our Daily Mile round the school grounds, which we have especially enjoyed in the sunny weather! With our Term 1 focus on Mental Health and Emotional Wellbeing, we will continue to use the '[Cool in School](#)' programme. Children have created a 'worry box', or have access to the worry monster for our classrooms and will be discussing who they can ask for help and also how they can assert themselves in potentially challenging situations by talking calmly and using confident body language. Please continue to encourage your child to share with one of their *three named people* or use our *worry box* or our *emotional check ins* if they have something on their mind.

## Religious Education



This term P4 will have a class retreat in school followed by Mass on Tuesday 29th September. The children will be preparing readings, prayers and hymns. There is also a Sacramental Information Evening for P4 Parents at St Joseph's Church on Tuesday 1st September at 6pm. We are exploring stories from the Gospel where Jesus showed love and compassion as He healed and helped others. Later in the term, we will begin preparing for our Advent Service which will be held on Friday 11th December at 2pm.

## Modern Languages



This term French will be taught by Miss Harvey. We will continue to learn classroom instructions and familiar vocabulary for conversations including the day and month, the weather and numbers from 0-40. We have been learning vocabulary for the family and will learn vocabulary for Months of the Year and birthdays. We will be using [these French activities](#) to practice our new vocabulary.
