What's included?

- One to one online 30 minute consultation
- Live demos of toys and technology
- Time for questions and answers
- Information sheets covering some of the ideas shared
- Possibility of loaning equipment
- Follow up support

Who is it for?

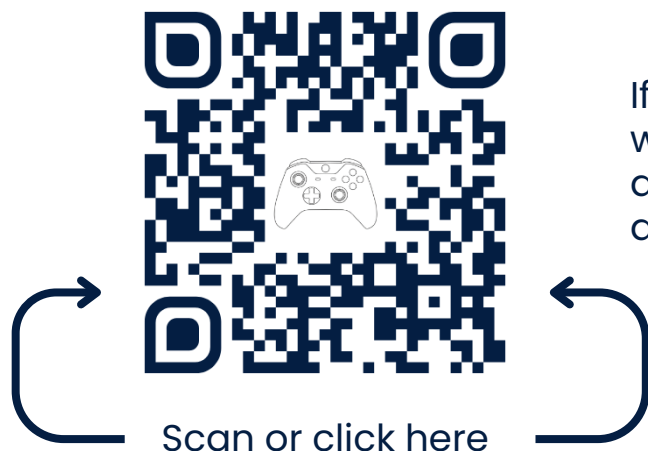
