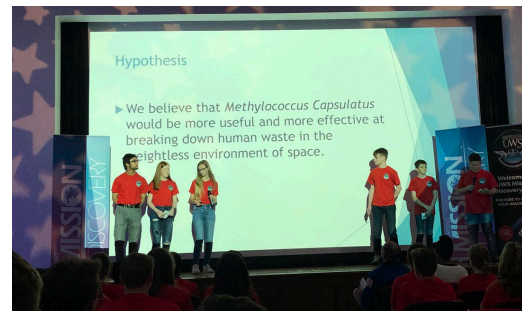
S2 ECO- Workshop
