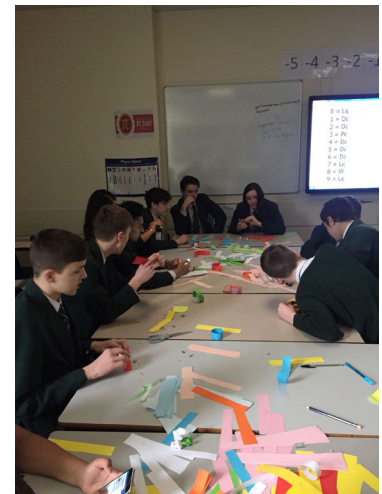

Pi Day with the Maths Department

The maths department hosted their annual Pi day celebration this month. Pi Day is celebrated on March 14th (3/14) around the world. The maths event celebrates π , the term used to describe the ratio of a circle's circumference to its diameter, commonly shortened to 3.14. Pi Day has been traced back to Larry Shaw, a physicist who is believed to have held the first ever Pi Day celebration in 1988.
