
P6/7 ERC Dance Competition

British Science Week 2015

British Science Week took place from 13th-22nd March with the highlight being the Solar Eclipse on Friday 20th! To mark the week, we were learning about scientists of the past and their contributions to our lives today. We also invited Steve Owens, a dark sky



specialist, to speak to the P4-7 about Space and the Solar Eclipse. All classes made eclipse viewers and viewed the fantastic spectacle on Friday morning using their viewers and special viewing glasses. In the afternoon, P1-2s decorated cakes to illustrate the solar eclipse, the P3-5s made models of the solar eclipse and the P6-7s looked at the theory of apparent size which explains why the Moon appears to cover the Sun despite the fact that it's much smaller!

We were also very lucky to have a group of S5/S6s from St. Luke's at St. Mark's on Friday afternoon to demonstrate a variety of Science experiments including: *elephant's toothpaste*, pocket rocket and hovercrafts amongst others. The week was a fantastic experience for all children and their enthusiasm and enjoyment of all activities was very clearly evident from their 'sunny' dispositions!!!
