Adverse Weather

• If the school is closed during the course of a school day you will be

contacted, in the first instance, by text message. <u>Please ensure we have a current mobile</u> phone number on our records for this purpose.

- The text will ask you to make arrangements to collect your child as soon as possible. You cannot reply to this message.
- Please don't telephone the school unless absolutely necessary as we have a limited number of external lines.
- Your child will be kept here until someone comes for him/her.
- Once the school has been officially closed regular updates will be posted on the East Renfrewshire and school website and updates posted on Twitter and Facebook.

In the event of heavy snow, as first priority, our janitor will clear a path to the breakfast club door from the stairs. Look out for signs directing you if we have to make any changes to the usual routine.

P1 Registration for pupils starting school in August 2016

East Renfrewshire Council has set up one week when you should register your son or daughter at your local primary school for school education in East Renfrewshire Council. You must register at your catchment school, even if you intend to make a placing request to another school or to defer your place and keep your son or daughter at home for another year.











You may choose to enrol your son or daughter in either the local denominational or local nondenominational school. The choice will determine the secondary school to which your child will transfer.

If he or she is aged five between 1st March 2016 and the end of February 2017 you should come along to the primary school between 1.30pm and 3.30pm any day during the week of Monday 11th January to Friday 15th January 2016.

You should bring your son or daughter's birth certificate, Baptismal certificate if you have one, your child benefit statement or a bank statement showing your benefit award, a copy of your current council tax notice and mortgage statement or rental agreement.

Open Day for New 2016 Primary One Parents/Carers

An open day for the new August intake will take place on Thursday 14th January 2016 at 9.30am and again at 2.00pm. This gives new parents the opportunity to come and visit the school.
