c. Council Tax Notice

- d. Mortgage Statement or Rental Agreement showing same name & address as on the child benefit letter
- e. Baptismal certificate if appropriate

Formal notice of the **REGISTRATION** process will be published in the press indicating that dates are between **Monday 13th and Friday 17th** January '14 in all local schools. For this purpose you must REGISTER at your catchment school.
