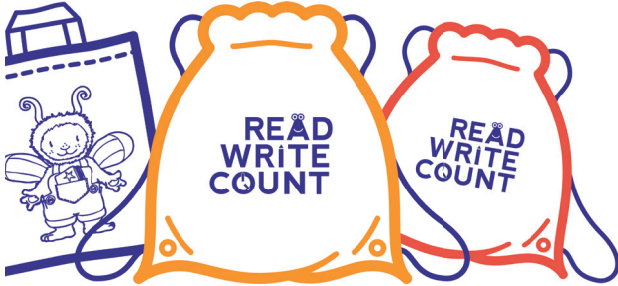
# LEARN TOGETHER
