St. Columba and his companions brought Christianity to Scotland and built an Abbey at Iona on the island of Mull. Here we also see a Celtic cross and the cross of St. Andrew in the sky.

We see three of the great Scottish saints who helped to develop the Faith of the people of Scotland: St. Margaret, St. Mungo and St. John Ogilvie.

The immigrant communities who have added a richness of Faith to Scotland are represented, including Irish, Italian,
Polish and Lithuanian workers.

The diversity of pupils attending Catholic schools, from different races and backgrounds, is reflected within the image.

The academic success enjoyed by pupils attending Catholic schools is reflected in the two students, in their academic gowns and holding a scroll, as testimony to those who have moved from Catholic schools into Higher Education.
