Block 2 P4b – 4, 11, 18 & 25 Mar, 1 & 22 April

Children must bring their swimming kit to school on these dates and should arrive at school no later than 8.45am. Please note children are not permitted to purchase anything from the vending machines whilst they are at the pool, therefore no additional money is required.

The total cost for the lessons is £6.00 for 6 lessons this is a reduced cost with the balance being supplemented by the school. All payments should be made online via ParentPay or via local shop using the Barcode which can be requested from the school office.
