Dear Parent/ Carer,

In line with Curriculum for Excellence guidelines, pupils participate in learning outdoors and outdoor PE lessons on a regular basis each week. Pupils will also play outdoors at break and lunchtime every day unless our dynamic risk assessment concludes that adverse weather makes it unsafe to do so. Please ensure that your child comes to school dressed appropriately for the weather. This is particularly important as we approach winter. All pupils should bring a waterproof jacket each day. Children are also encouraged to wear wellies or winter boots on wet or snowy days and are welcome to bring a change of footwear to wear indoors. PE kit should include jogging trousers or leggings along with their PE top and a jumper or cardigan and trainers. Waterproof jackets can also be worn during PE.
