#### Foundation Apprenticeships

- Foundation Apprenticeships are a work-based learning opportunity for secondary school pupils in S4 and S5.
   Young people spend time out of school at college or with a local employer, and complete the Foundation Apprenticeship alongside their other subjects like National 5s and Highers.
- The qualification takes two years to complete and is linked to one of six key sectors of the Scottish economy, so young people are getting industry experience which will help them kick-start a successful career in their chosen field.
