Best Start Grants and Best Start Foods

Best Start Grant and Best Start Foods are payments that help towards the costs of being pregnant or looking after a child. Best Start Grant and Best Start Foods are 2 separate payments. You apply for both Best Start Grant and Best Start Foods using the same form.

You may be able to get Best Start Grant and Best Start Foods if all of the following apply:

- you live in Scotland
- you or your partner are getting certain benefits or tax credits
- you or your partner are pregnant, or are the main person looking after a baby or child who's the right age for a payment

Good News Story – Armed Services Advice Project (ASAP)

Client contacted ERCAB as he is suffering from poor mental health & had his Universal Credit (UC) sanctioned. He was unsure what to do and was struggling financially to cope. He is unemployed and lives alone, is ex-army and has his child with him 3 days per week. Client was also struggling with fuel costs so our ASAP adviser set up an appointment with Utilita on his behalf.

ERCAB's ASAP adviser also made a referral for a Scottish Welfare Fund Crisis Grant, shopping vouchers & fuel vouchers. Client was also supported with a UC mandatory reconsideration. A referral to Combat Stress & SSAFA was also made and he was provided with a SIM card for his Giff Gaff phone for 6 months.

Client was overwhelmed with the support he had received from ERCAB and would not have been able to do this on his own.
