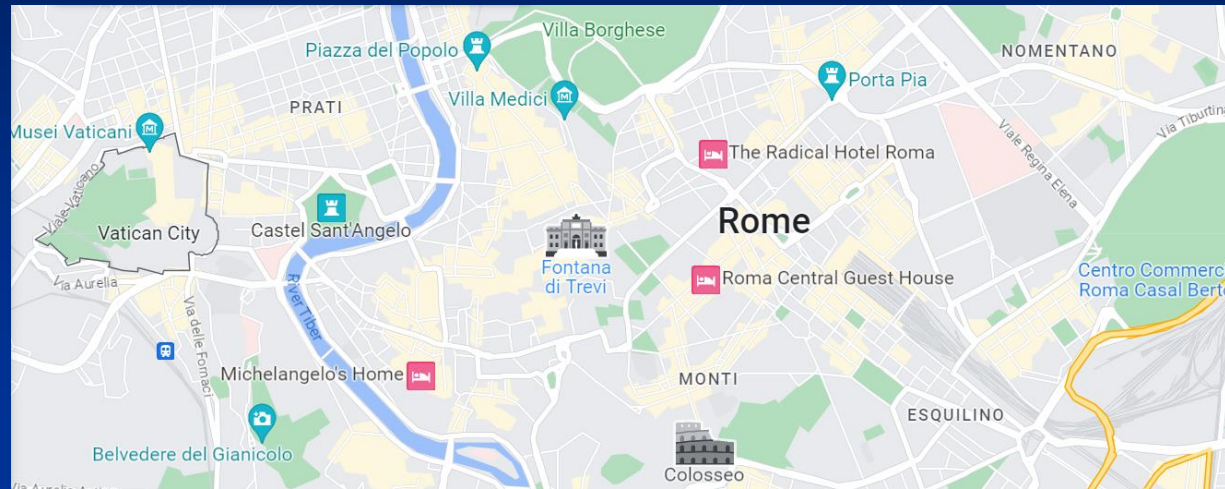

Travelling

- We are flying with Jet2 airlines.
- Flights are direct from Glasgow to Rome's Fiumicino Airport.
- Small bag allowed for cabin baggage (no liquids over 100ml).
- All members of the group must adhere to security procedures.
- Hold Luggage Allowance **22kg.**
- Bring something to eat for travelling

Itinerary Friday

- 0700 Breakfast
- 0730 Inspection of rooms
- 0800 Leave hotel for airport

Food

- Breakfast provided every day in hotel. Continental style, cold meats, rolls, coffee, orange juice etc.
- Dinner Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday in local restaurant just along from hotel.
- On Thursday night we will have dinner in Hard Rock Cafe
- Pupils will have free time for lunch, which they will need to buy.
- There is a supermarket near the hotel where pupils can stock up on crisps, snacks, juice etc.



Moving round Rome Safely

- Most of the time we will be together as a group
- When given free time pupils must go in groups of AT LEAST 2/3
- Pupil free time is controlled- regular check-ins
- Mobile numbers – pupils / staff – **Whatsapp**
- When we arrive in Rome on the first day we will encourage your son/daughter to send a text



Moving round Rome Safely

- Traffic
- Pick Pockets
- Comfortable shoes/ Appropriate Dress
- Passports in Safe throughout trip
- Travel folder & GHIC with me at all times
- Passports & GHIC returned to pupils on journey home
- Remember no news is good news- don't worry!



Spending Money

- Pupils will pay for their own lunch and any snacks
- Don't take too much money
- This will be kept in the hotel safe and will be given out at set times.
- Pupils may prefer to use/ combination of Apple Pay/ Google Wallet.
- You can also take a small number of pounds for the journey out and journey back.



Medical Conditions

- If your son or daughter has any type of medical condition or allergy, you **must** inform school staff about this. This is the case even if the condition appears to have lapsed and/or if your son or daughter is experiencing symptoms of a condition or allergy that has yet to be diagnosed.
- A school consent form **must** be completed prior to departure which should clearly state any diagnosed or undiagnosed medical condition. If you require a new consent form to update this section of the form please ask for one as soon as possible.



Medicines

- If your son or daughter requires **any type** of medication it must be declared on the appropriate form
- As pupils are S6 they will be responsible for their own medication unless special conditions are required eg needs to be kept cold.
- Pupils should bring spare medication.



Medicines

- Please ensure liquid medicines or epi pens that need to be taken in hand luggage meet airport guidelines and include a letter from your GP if necessary.
- If any pupil suffers travel sickness could they make sure they take whatever medication they are used to.

Passport/GHIC Cards

- Please ensure you have handed in your son/daughter's Passport and GHIC card
- Passports must be in date according to new laws (6months).
- You DO NOT need your own insurance
- Please check you have necessary visa if required



Packing the Essentials

- Comfortable footwear – We will be doing a lot of walking.
- Cover Up – Some of the attractions we will visit will not permit entry with bare shoulders or legs.
- A light water proof jacket – At this time of year there can be shower bursts.
- Sun Cream – The weather may be warm and sunny.
- Football colours cannot be worn at any times during the trip.



Code of Conduct

- ▶ Pupils are representing our school on this trip.
- ▶ All pupils and parents/carers must sign the code of conduct.
- ▶ Pupils will be expected to give of their best at all times.
- ▶ Pupils will be held to the code of conduct.
- ▶ Groups / rooms / keeping together / safety
- ▶ Show consideration for other students and staff at all times



Code of Conduct

- Do your best to get on with everyone on the trip. Try to get to know other pupils better
- There must be no consumption of alcohol at any time on the trip. Students who fail to follow this condition will be sent home at their expense

Travelling to and from Rome

- Ensure that your luggage meets the requirements of the airline and security. The baggage limit must be adhered to. Additional charges are expensive and can cause delays. Check Jet2 website for up-to-date information.
- You should be very clear that airlines have the right to refuse to carry persons who have consumed alcohol. The school will take disciplinary action against any pupil who has consumed alcohol
- Be considerate of other passengers on the plane and in the airport
- When travelling by coach stay seated and keep your seatbelts fastened at all times
- Dispose of any rubbish thoughtfully (bin bags will be provided)
- Football colours cannot be worn at any times during the trip
- There are particular souvenir items which could cause serious problems. Don't buy any sort of knife, replica weapons or any laser pens



Hotel Dei Mille

- Hotel rooms should be kept tidy to allow cleaning staff to do their job
- Cooperate with the Fire Drill which will be carried out on the first evening
- Be on time when specific times are given for meetings
- Keep noise to a minimum in the hotel. Be mindful of other guests
- Report any breakages immediately to a member of staff
- The group will return to the hotel quite late each night. Pupils will be given a limited amount of time before being asked to settle down for the night. Pupils should do their best to settle down quickly



Hotel Dei Mille

- Hotel rooms must be kept locked from inside at night
- If a pupil feels alarmed for any reason during the night, they should phone the party leader's room immediately. Room/phone numbers will be issued on arrival
- No person other than hotel staff or members of our party is allowed into rooms allocated to our party
- No member of our party is allowed in the room of someone outwith our party
- Members of our party should not enter areas of the hotel other than the close vicinity to our allocated rooms
- Pupils should take care on hotel balconies. No pupil should be on a hotel balcony during hours of darkness
- Rooms must be cleared of rubbish and will be inspected before departure



The following items should be handed in before the trip:

1. Current individual passport and visa (if required)
2. Current General Health Insurance Card
3. Signed Parental Consent form
4. Administration of Medicine Form. This should be signed by all parent/guardian of every pupil going on the trip
5. Signed acceptance of code of contact
