SQA Exam Results 2024

On Tuesday the 6th August all pupils who sat national examinations will receive their result by first class post. Pupils have been encouraged to sign up to MySQA service which allows candidates to receive their exam results by text and email. Registration for this service is online at www.mysqa.info and candidates will require their SCN and a unique email address.

Listed below is advice to support our young people on receiving their results:

- Candidates will receive their certificates by first class post. Mr Cumming will be available in school on that day with other members of the SLT to deal with results queries – **0141 577 2000**.
- The SQA have a Candidate Advice Line which will deal with general information on the layout of the SQA Certificate which is **0345 279 1000**.
- Please note that all queries about results should be directed to the school.

Appeals service 2024

Appeals 2024 is a free service that you can use if you have concerns about a grade (or grades) on your results certificate. You can appeal directly to the SQA or contact the school to do this for you.

The service will open on Results Day, Tuesday 6th August at 9am, and the learner direct submission deadlines are:

Tuesday 13 August at 11.59 pm for priority appeals

Tuesday 27 August at 11.59pm for all other appeals

Your appeal can be prioritised if you have a conditional place at university or college, or in training or employment that depends on your grade.

What is Appeals 2024?

If you appeal your grade, a senior marker will carry out a marking review of your SQA-marked assessments.

This is not a re-mark.

A marking review checks that:

- all parts of your SQA-assessments have been marked;
- the marking is in line with national standards;
- the marks given for each answer have been totalled correctly; and
- the correct result has been entered on our system.

Please note that after being reviewed, your result could stay the same, go up or go down.

As the academic year draws to a close, I wish all of our pupils and their families a restful holiday and I hope that the 6th of August is a day where they are rewarded for all their hard work. Thank you on behalf of the staff and myself for your continued support and commitment and I look forward to working with you again during the next academic year.
