Points to note

 Soft entry will begin at 8.50am from Monday 26th August i.e. infant doors will open at 8.50am. The janitor can supervise in the playground from 8.40am. Children should enter the school via the infant doors and go direct to the P.E hall (with jackets and bags) for a quick morning check-in with the Head Teacher. If there is severe weather we will aim





to open the doors by 8.45am at the latest. (*This change is due to a reduction in allocated classroom assistant hours.)
