Full Reopening of Schools P1-7

We can't wait for all pupils to return to full time education in school on Monday 15th March. Our pupils, teachers and families have done an amazing job during this incredibly difficult time.

This letter outlines some key guidelines and practical information regarding the full return to school on Monday (similar to August – December).

The appropriate public health measures will be in place including:

- Enhanced hand hygiene and cleaning practices
- Regular washing of hands
- Physical distancing between adults in school including parents at drop off and pick up
- Face coverings worn by adults in the school
- **All pupils must enter and leave through their allocated door (same as Term 1)**
- Children should be dropped off and collected by one adult only
- Adults must wear a face covering when in the school grounds
- Increased use of PPE
- Rapid response Covid-19 testing for staff

Doors will open from 8.50am and the school day will end at **3pm for P1-3 + siblings** and **3.05pm for P4-7**.

I hope you find the above information helpful and reassuring.

We look forward to seeing ALL of our children back where they belong on Monday 15th March.
