

## **Before**



If reading the class book, your child can tell you about the story in a sentence or two.

If reading a new book, ask your child what could the story be about after reading the title and looking at the picture.



## **During**

Encourage your child to check what they are saying makes sense, sounds right and looks right!

Praise them if they self-correct or confirm by repeating words or phrases.





Return to a page your child read that sounded good and praise them!

Go back to a word or phrase that they problem solved and fixed.

Ask them what their favourite part was and what questions they have about the story.

Look at the first letter.

Look for words
you already
know
inside the
word.

Get your mouth ready for the first sound.



Use the picture to help with meaning.

Follow along with your finger to help keep your place.

(Don't overuse!)





Repeat a word or phrase to check it makes sense.

Run your
finger all the
way through the
word and
say it
slowly
to
check.

Does it look right?
Does it sound
right?
Does it
make

sense?

Make your reading sound smooth like talking.
