Harvest/Food Pantry

Following our Harvest assembly on Friday, we would like to launch our Thornliebank Food Pantry which is in our Family Room. All families can 'take what you need, bring what you can' and we will endeavour to keep the pantry stocked with non-perishable items throughout the year for anyone who needs them. If you are able to and would like to, please send any items you would like to donate for the pantry in with your child next week as a 'harvest collection'. This will build up a supply of items available to start us off. The pantry will be open on Mondays from 8.30 until 9.30 and again

from 2.00 - 3.30pm and you can make a request for items through email. All requests will be kept completely confidential. We hope to have a Google Form for requests very soon.

Uniform

Our school colours are black and yellow and pupils may wear different items of this colour to school each day. PE kit in these colours should be worn to school on PE days—Primary 6 & 7 should wear a shirt and tie on days they do not have PE. Please name all items sent into school — we have already amassed a large amount of unnamed lost property which is now being laundered and added to our recycled uniform rail and store. If anyone requires any school clothing items please email school for the attention of Mrs McGarvey and we will do our best to provide the sizes you require, we can also make referrals to the East Renfrewshire School Uniform Bank for those struggling to provide school uniform items. We are currently happy to take donations of polo shirts, school shirts and other PE kit such as joggers, leggings and shorts. We will also happily take donations of outdoor waterproof suits and wellingtons. If any parent has a little time available and would like to help with our recycled rail please speak with Mrs McGarvey.

Please check bags, particularly of younger pupils, as we have had a number of items lost recently items such as pencils cases, water bottles and named school clothing – it is very easy for younger pupils to mistake items for their own. Please send such items back to school and check clothing brought home for other pupil's names.
