Gaelic Medium Primary Education Provision

Following the consultation on Gaelic Medium Education Provision being located at Thornliebank, elected members met last week and voted in favour of this proposal. This means that from August 2023, a new provision offering education in the Gaelic language will be situated here. I am meeting with the Education Department early in the new year to begin to make plans for this, and I will keep you all informed as I have more information. This is an exciting time for Thornliebank, and we will embrace the added diversity that this will bring to our community.

Last Day of Term

The school and nursery both close at 2:30 on Friday 23rd December. Children can wear non-uniform this day, including Christmas jumpers or festive items if they like. We re-open on Thursday 5th January 2023.
