Gaelic Medium Primary Education (GMPE)

Last week, we appointed our Gaelic Medium Principal Teacher, who we expect to start in May. His name is Mr. Adam McColgan- Smith, and he is currently Principal Teacher Sgoil na Coille Nuaidh (James Hamilton Gaelic School) in East Ayrshire. We look forward to him starting with us, and I am certain he will do a wonderful job of introducing Gaelic into our school community.

In terms of more information around the GMPE provision, we are still waiting on more information from the Scottish Government and the local authority. We have prioritised recruiting the Principal Teacher, as they will play a key role in preparing for the GMPE classes starting in August, and he will be involved in the recruitment process for additional Gaelic-speaking staff (initially the plans are for a part-time teacher and a Pupil Support Assistant).

I will continue to keep you updated as and when more information becomes available.

Thornliebank Together – Participatory Budgeting Grant

Thank you to everyone who came down to Thorntree Hall on 18th March to vote for our school and nursery to receive participatory budgeting funding. We applied for money to help us buy an Operation Play Outdoors 'loose parts' hub, and also to buy sturdy storage for the nursery's wellies

and muddy jackets. We were successful in both our bids, and I am delighted to share with you that we were awarded a total of £4000!

In addition to this, the Parent Council applied for money from the Humanitarian Fund and were successfully awarded this too! This money, plus the £2000 from the event at Thorntree Hall, should be enough to fund the Operation Play Outdoors hub! I am sure you will see the excited faces when this arrives through our Twitter pictures.

Cultural Celebration

Thank you to Mrs. McGarvey and the Diversity Champions group, who have organised different ways for the school community to share in Ramadan and Eid celebrations.
