Gaelic Medium Primary Education (GMPE)

Mr. McColgan-Smith is settling in nicely to the Thornliebank team, and is getting to know all the pupils in his first few weeks. He is working hard behind the scenes to get everything organised for our new Gaelic Medium Provision to be ready in August, including ordering Gaelic curricular resources, translating resources into Gaelic and working on our website. We had a successful Early Years play session for families with pupils in the early years who want to find out more about Gaelic Medium education. If you know anyone who would like to find out more, please encourage them to get in touch. We are interviewing for our part-time Gaelic Medium teacher later in the month, so I will keep you posted with the outcome of this recruitment process.

Transitions

<u>P7 to S1</u>- Our P7 pupils continue their transition programme, with visits to their secondary schools planned for early in June. Staff from associated secondary schools have already been coming to visit for some time, to build relationships with the pupils.

<u>Nursery to P1</u>- Mrs. MacAskill and Miss Vannet will visit all our incoming P1 children at their nurseries, to meet them before the induction programme begins. Mr. McColgan-Smith will visit all our incoming P1s who will learn in Gaelic. We have 3 P1 induction afternoons planned (2nd, 8th and 13th June) where the P1s will see their classroom, meet their teacher and their P7 buddies.

<u>Class-to-class</u> – We have not yet finalised which teachers will be taking on which classes next year, but in June all classes will have a Meet The Teacher afternoon, and they will have the opportunity to get to know their new teacher. In the final week of term, we plan for all classes to move to their new classroom so they can practise where to line up, and get familiar with their new learning environment.

School App (XPressions)

Our school app is up and running! The app is an easy way to contact us and find information such as newsletters, school holidays and lunch menus all in one place. Search for the Xpressions app on your app store, or visit xpressions.groupcall.com

SeeSaw App-Learning Journal

We have started using a new app in P2 and P3, called SeeSaw. It's an online learning journal, where pupils can share pictures, videos, schoolwork and voice notes on a regular basis with their families. Parents use an app to view posts, and there is a space where teachers, pupils and parents can comment. You can even share it with wider families like grandparents! We hope that sharing more about the school day with you will build relationships with families, and improve communication between school and home. It will give you a chance to see parts of the school day that aren't possible to show you at the moment, and act as a great talking point when your child comes home and you want to chat about their day. The app is completely secure, and safe to use. In August, we plan to roll SeeSaw out to the whole school, which we are very excited about.

Developing our Outdoor Space- Help Wanted!

We are still looking for a team of volunteers to come in and help us to do some gardening and developing our outdoor space. As you may remember, we were successful in gaining a £2000 grant at the end of last year to develop a sensory garden/ outdoor space, and now we have some nicer weather on the way we would like to get started.
