First day of school...

Our staff are already in school preparing for Wednesday, and we are all excited to welcome the children back to school this week! Please note that new Primary 1 and Clas 1 pupils will not start until 9.15am on the first day only, giving us time to get the older children in and settled before our new starts arrive. New P1 and Clas 1 pupils and families should gather in the infant playground where staff will meet you at 9.15am. Adults are welcome to come into school with the new children to help reassure them on the first day and to take photos of the momentous occasion! For the first day only, P1 and Clas 1 pupils should be collected at 2.45pm. As of Thursday they will follow the usual school day of 9.00am until 3.00pm.

For all other children, school will start at 9.00am on Wednesday 14th August. The children should know where to line up as they were shown when they met their new teacher back in June, but there will be staff around on the day in case anyone is not sure. P2 and P3 pupils should gather in the infant playground to come in the infant door, P4 and P5 pupils will enter via the main door of the older building, P6 will enter via the door in the bottom playground nearer the car park and P7 will enter via the door in the bottom playground nearer the nursery. Classes will be dismissed from these doors at 3.00pm.

School Absence and Latecoming

Please remember that school starts at 9.00am. It is very important that children are here on time, as it ensures they have a settled start to their day and are part of the morning routine where they will find out what will be happening that day, order their lunch and have their attendance noted. If your child arrives late to school and the rest of the class have already gone inside with their teacher, please bring your child to the school office and they will be directed to their class from there

There is adult supervision in the playgrounds from 8.45am for children who arrive early. Please note that we are not responsible for your child should they access the playground prior to this time.

If your child is going to be absent from school, please call the school office as early as possible to let us know the reason for their absence and how long you expect them to be off school.

If your child has an appointment during the school day, please let us know so we can get them ready to be collected at the office. We would very much appreciate you giving us as much notice as possible if you wish to collect your child for an appointment, as it can be difficult to pass on messages at the last minute if our office is short staffed.

If you are going to be late to collect your child from school, please contact the school office in plenty of time so that we can get a message to their class teacher and ensure that they come to the school office to wait safely until they are collected.

Breakfast Cart

You may be aware that East Renfrewshire Council has funded a breakfast cart in Thornliebank for the past few years, providing free toast and fruit from 8.45am. At the moment, we are waiting to find out if this service is able to continue, so unfortunately there will be no breakfast cart provision in the meantime. We will keep you updated on this matter.

Meet the Teacher Event

We are already looking forward to welcoming you into school for our first partnership event of the new session. Our Meet the Teacher evening will take place on Wednesday 21st August between 5.00pm and 6.00pm. Parents and carers are invited into school to visit your child's class, have a look around the learning environment, collect a copy of the class newsletter and meet your child's class teacher. This is an informal evening aimed at making initial introductions between families and school staff at the start of the year, and you are not required to stay for the duration - please feel free to pop in any time between 5.00pm and 6.00pm. There will not be any presentations - the class newsletters will contain all the key information for the term and year ahead.

Please note that Meet the Teacher is not an appropriate forum to discuss anything specific about your child with their class teacher as it is not a private meeting. You can contact the school office if you wish to speak to the teacher separately. All members of the Senior Leadership Team will be available on the evening, should you have anything specific you wish to discuss.

If you are unable to attend, a copy of the newsletter will be emailed out to everyone the following day. We hope you are able to make it along and look forward to welcoming you into school on the night.

Primary 7 Lockerbie Information Evening

Our Primary 7 residential trip is booked for 10^{th} - 14^{th} March 2025 at Lockerbie Manor. We know that this is an exciting part of the Primary 7 year and that lots of the children have already been talking about it prior to moving into P7 this week. We will be holding an information evening in school on Wednesday 21^{st} August at 6.00pm, straight after Meet the Teacher. P7 pupils, parents and carers are all invited along to find out more about what to expect from the residential trip and to ensure that families have all the information they need in order to make the decision as to whether or not your child will be attending. Mrs Wilson will be sending out a separate letter with more details.

School Meals

Every child in Primary 1 to 5 currently receives a free school meal. Pupils in P6 and 7 require a ParentPay account to allow them to order and pay for their lunch. Lunches are ordered in class first thing each morning to allow the kitchen staff enough time to prepare what is required and minimise waste. A copy of the menu has been sent out with this newsletter so you can discuss the options with your child (parents/carers of our younger children can find this helpful).

The first day back after a holiday is always the Monday menu for that week and then the normal days will follow.

Our catering manager is available to meet with parents/carers to discuss and plan for any food intolerances or dietary requirements - please contact the school office to arrange this.

Nut-free School

Please note that we are a nut-free school, due to a number of children with severe allergies. Children should not bring snacks or lunch items containing nuts, including Nutella. Thank you for your co-operation with this.

School Uniform and PE Kit

As a reminder, our school uniform is as follows:

Black trousers/shorts/skirt/leggings

Black sweatshirt*

Yellow or black polo shirt for P1-5*

White shirt and school tie for P6/7

Black shoes

On PE days, your child should wear their PE kit to school, to save time changing during the school day. PE kit is as follows:

Black shorts/joggers/leggings

Yellow or white polo shirt or t-shirt*

Appropriate footwear for indoor or outdoor PE

* Polo shirts, t-shirts and sweatshirts do not have to have the Thornliebank logo - plain ones can be purchased from most supermarkets to keep costs down. If you do wish to have uniform items with the school logo, these can be purchased online from Schoolwear Made Easy.

There is a separate logo and tie for children attending Bun-sgoil Ghàidhlig Thornliebank.

Personal belongings and water bottles

Please ensure that all personal belongings and water bottles are labelled with your child's name. You would not believe how quickly our lost property box fills up and overflows with un-named items after just a couple of days back in school. Every child should bring a water bottle to school each day. There are water coolers in both building where they can be refilled. We discourage children from bringing juice in their water bottles and fizzy drinks are not permitted.

Family Support

Nicola Reid-Taylor from the financial inclusion service is based in our school each Wednesday morning in the Family Room and can help with any claims for Free School Meals, Uniform Grants and other help with cost of living.
