Parts of the Sewing Machine

Sewing machines vary in design but they all have the same parts.

Try to match up the parts you have learned in class with the correct description of what it does.

Name of part	What it does
Thread holder 	When this is pressed it will stitch backwards to reinforce the beginning and end of a line of stitching.
Stitch width selector 	This holds the fabric down flat and stops it from slipping out.
Reverse stitch button 	Pressing this selects different types of stitches.
Stitch length selector 	You can adjust how wide the stitches are with this.
Presser Foot 	As well as the foot control this will adjust how fast or slow you can go.
Presser foot lever 	You can adjust the length of the stitch using this button.
Speed control 	This is where you put the reel when winding the spool and when you are stitching.
Bobbin 	You can adjust the speed of the machine with this.
Foot control 	This is necessary in order that a stitch is formed. It is wound at the top of the machine.
Pattern selector 	This will put the presser foot up or down and will also 'beep' if you forget to put it down before stitching.
