### **EASTER SCHOOL 2014**

Today I issued to all pupils in S4, S5 and S6 a copy of the Easter School timetable for April 2014. It is also available on the school website. Easter School is an excellent opportunity for pupils to do some extra revision and to ask for help with anything they have not fully understood. It complements the private study that they will already be doing and the supported study programme which runs in school. I would encourage pupils to take advantage of as many Easter School sessions as possible.

This session, a flat rate of £39 is payable which entitles pupils to attend as many sessions as they wish during the two weeks of Easter School. Whilst the vast majority of our pupils take advantage of both weeks, some children attend sessions during only one week, often as a result of a family holiday. Pupils attending sessions during only one of the two weeks of Easter School will be charged a reduced rate of £21 for week 1 (5 days) and £18 for week 2 (4 days). In line with Council policy, **pupils entitled to free school meals will continue to access Easter Schools free of charge.**

As always, the number of places available for each session will be subject to teacher availability. Class teachers will give pupils the opportunity to register for Easter School sessions over the course of the next two weeks and places will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis. Pupils are welcome to attend sessions at Easter School for which they have not registered, but they should be aware that a space cannot always be guaranteed in these circumstances.

Payment for Easter School can be made online by following the link from the school website ([www.williamwood.e-renfrew.sch.uk](http://www.williamwood.e-renfrew.sch.uk)) to the Payments4Schools service. You need to click on *pay for school meals*, then click on *school payment*, then select *Williamwood High School* and finally select *Easter School 2014*.

In order to make an online payment, you will need to enter your child's Scottish Candidate Number which you will find on the reverse side of this letter. Alternatively, payment can be made at the school office by cash or by cheque made payable to East Renfrewshire Council using the tear-off slip overleaf.

**Please note that payment for Easter School should be made by Friday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2014 at the latest.**
