CoWriter7 – Supporting Pupils with Dyslexia and Writing Difficulties.

Since CoWriter7 the whole site licence has been purchased for Williamwood High School, pupils across all year groups are benefitting from this invaluable support. The S1 and S4 pupils are currently receiving basic training in CoWriter7 with a view to building skills towards independence. This training will continue with S2, S3 and S5 pupils during this academic year as they are given opportunities to learn the basic facilities and can experience success with the support.

Pupils with dyslexia can be more independent with their spelling and writing and can access this support for extended writing tasks in any class, either on the desktop computers or by collecting a new netbook from the Support for Learning Department. They are also being encouraged to use this support in their assessments.

It is extremely important for pupils to bring their own headphones to school at all times so that they can access both Ivona and CoWriter in class and benefit from the audio support when appropriate.
