

**ARRANGEMENTS FOR EASTER SCHOOL
WILLIAMWOOD HIGH SCHOOL 2016**

Dear Student,

Easter School sessions will run over a total of five days of the Easter holiday. The days have been divided into 3 sessions, each lasting two periods. You will notice that some subjects run for only one session, others for two sessions and, in some cases, for the full day. Pupils need not attend all sessions. For example, where a subject is on offer for the full day you may choose to attend for the morning sessions only, thus allowing you to opt into another subject in the afternoon. More detailed information and advice will be given to you by your subject teachers.

I would ask you to take this timetable home with you and to consider carefully which sessions you plan to attend. You may sign up for as many sessions as you wish. Where there is a clash of subjects, you should attend the session which will be of most benefit to you in the final SQA examination. Take advice from your pupil support teacher if you are unsure.

From Tuesday of next week, teachers will ask pupils in their classes to sign up for the sessions that they wish to attend. By signing up in advance, you will be sure of a place in that class. You may still attend other sessions, **even if you have not signed up for them**, provided that there are sufficient spaces remaining.

Although the Easter School programme is an extensive one, it is still possible that there could be some sessions for which demand will outstrip available places. In these circumstances, departments will offer places on a 'first-come-first-served' basis. Please be assured that additional support will continue to be offered over the remainder of the term and in the week following the Easter break in the form of both formal and informal supported study. Any pupils who miss out on an Easter School session as a result of excessive demand for places should speak to their teachers about future supported study sessions that may be of help to them.

Pupils are not required to wear school uniform at Easter School, but they will be asked to sign in each day for security purposes. Please note that food may be purchased (using cash) from the cafeteria during Easter School.
