

Diana Award - Nomination Form - For Nominees

The Diana Award is a nationally recognised award. We can nominate pupils but the ultimate decision is made by the award body. In order to complete the full online nomination form, I require some detailed information about your achievements as an individual or a group.

You will also be required to provide a written statement from someone who has benefited from your activity as well as details of a referee as well.

Nomination Criteria and Eligibility

In order to be eligible for The Diana Award nominees must be aged **9-18** and have been carrying out their activities for a **minimum of 12 months.** Nominators must know the young person in a professional capacity and be able to demonstrate the nominee's impact in **5** key criterion areas. Demonstrates commitment and passion to the cause, evidenced through their service to that cause and through social action

Service Journey

Evidence of transformation throughout the nominee(s') service journey, including attitude, skills gained and challenges overcome

Social Impact

Creates positive social change that is of benefit to the wider community

Inspiring Others

Through their positive attitude and passionate approach to life they are a role model to others

Youth Led

Demonstrates how the young person(s) have led, owned and shaped the activities they are nominating them for

• How have you taken ownership of your activities? Did you initiate your chosen activities on your own?

Demonstrates how you have led, owned and shaped the activities you being nominating for.

Service Journey:

• How have you benefitted as a direct result of taking part in the activities that you have been involved in?

Evidence of transformation throughout your service journey, including attitude, skills gained and challenges overcome.

Beneficiary:

Please provide a written statement from someone who has benefited from your activities. This **must** include their full name and contact email address.

Referee:

Please include the full name, job title, organisation, relationship to you and a contact email address of another adult (who is not a family member) who can act as a referee to provide a reference. You can use your Pupil Support Teacher for this.
