Aamer Anwar

Brought up in Liverpool, Aamer came to Scotland in 1986 graduating from Glasgow University with an MA Hons in Social Sciences. From 1992-94 he was the Scottish organiser for the Anti-Nazi League and over the years has been described as one of Scotland's leading human rights campaigners.

In 1995 Aamer made legal history in a successful civil action against Strathclyde Police following a racist attack on him in 1991. A lawyer since 2000 Aamer has been instructed in some of Scotland's highest profile cases. He acts for the family of Sheku Bayoh in the matter of his controversial death in police custody, as well as the family of murder victim Emma Caldwell. Most recently he successfully took on the Spanish state over their attempt to extradite ex-Catalan minister Clara Ponsati.

In October 2016, Aamer's unrelenting 17 year campaign finally helped secure a conviction for the murder of Surjit Singh Chhokar, described as Scotland's Stephen Lawrence. The case placed victim's rights at the heart of the criminal justice system and exposed institutional racism.

Building a fearsome reputation in Civil Liberties, Aamer was named Solicitor of the Year in 2016 and Lawyer of the Year in 2017 at the Legal Awards of Scotland. In 2017 he returned to the University of Glasgow where he was appointed as Rector. In any spare time, Aamer is a busy father of three young children.
