



Adverse Weather Communication

In the unlikely event of a school closure due to adverse weather conditions, the school will communicate this information by:

- SMS text message
- posting on the school Twitter feed
- posting on the school website
- telephoning the parents of pupils who require additional help travelling to and from school

Parents should take the following preparatory action:

- ensure that contact details are kept up to date, especially mobile telephone numbers
- discuss with your son or daughter a plan of action should the school be closed early or travel disrupted
- enlist the help of relatives or neighbours if there is a likelihood that you will be unable to meet or supervise your son or daughter should the school be closed early or travel be disrupted
