Face Coverings

You will have heard on the news on Friday that face coverings must now be worn by adults and pupils in the senior phase (S4 to S6) in classrooms, in addition to all communal areas and corridors. This information will be shared with pupils in their period 1 classes on Monday morning. Pupils in S1 to S3 who choose to wear a face covering in class may, of course, continue to do so.

Face coverings must also be worn by visitors to the school site, even when not entering the building (e.g. parents picking up or dropping off children).
