

MICROSOFT TEAMS | How To Guide



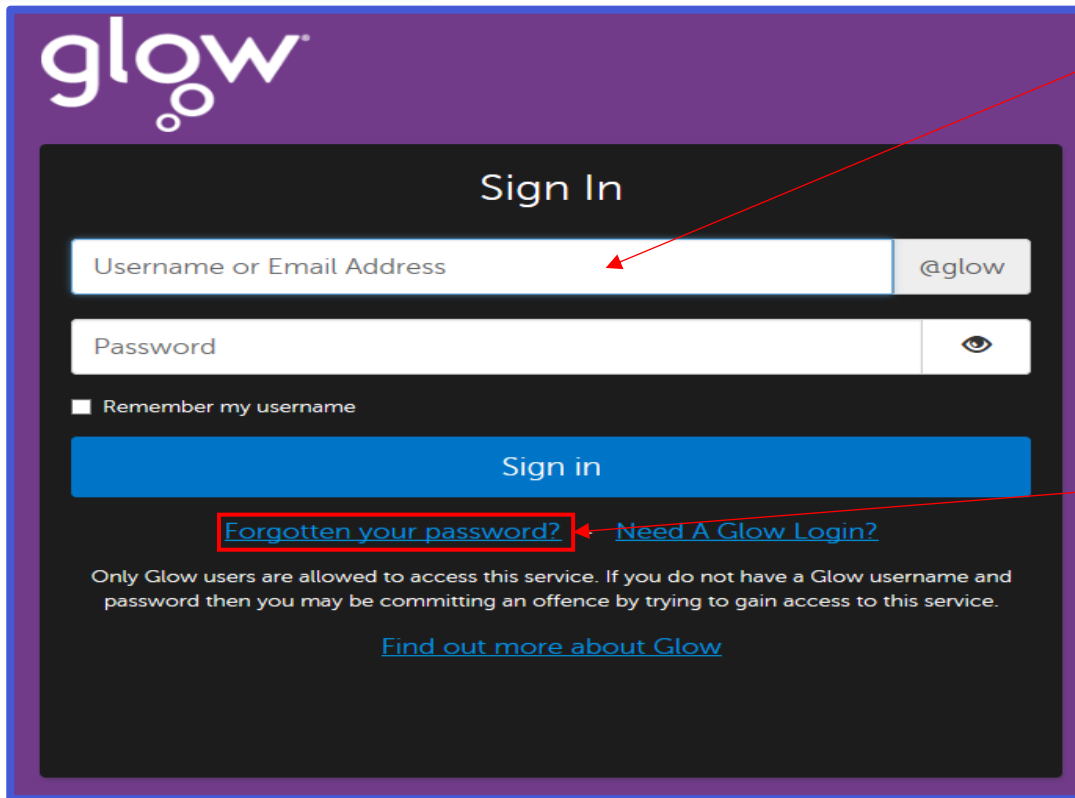
This is a step-by-step guide on how to:

- Access Microsoft Teams
- Find your class page
- Find any Homework Assignments that have been posted
- Find Home Learning resources
- How to submit assignments
- How to ask the teacher questions

(ATTENTION: If you can already access Microsoft Teams but aren't sure how to navigate it, skip to **Step 3.**)



Step One:

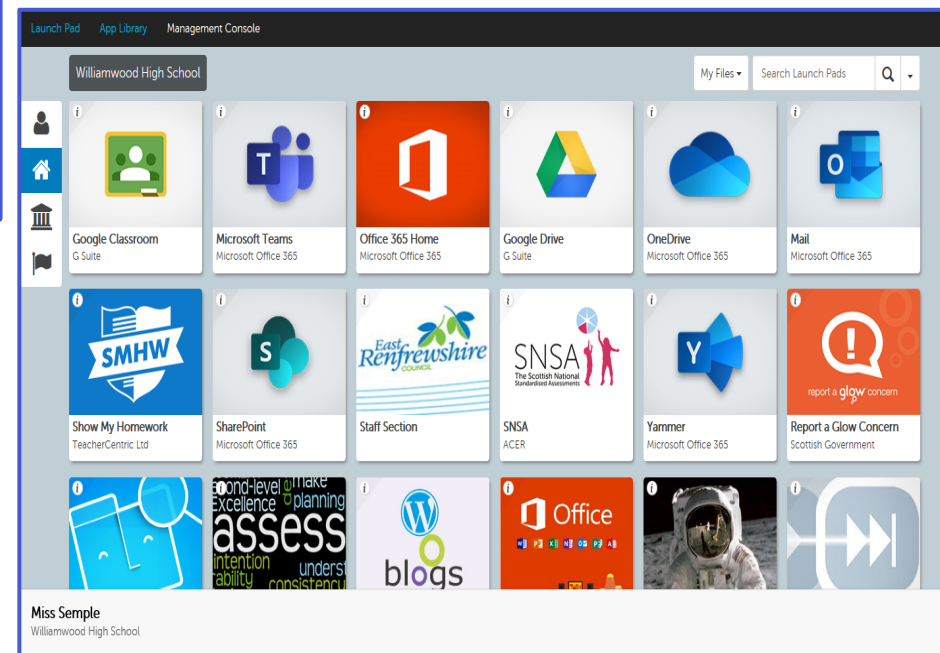
The first thing you will need to do to access Microsoft Teams, is to log onto your Glow homepage. You can do this using your 'gw(year of registering)(surname)(first name)' login. (You do not have to type in '@glow' or anything, the system does this for you.)

If you aren't sure of your Glow Login, most S1 logins begin with 'gw13', this may help.

Your password can be changed simply by clicking the 'Forgotten Password?' button and following the instructions.

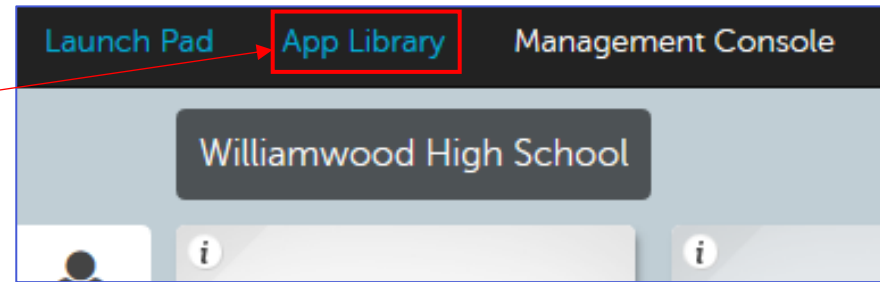
When you have successfully logged in, you will see all of the App Tiles appear. Google Classroom and other Apps will all be here.

You may already have **Microsoft Teams** added to your homepage. If you don't, please follow the steps on the following slide.

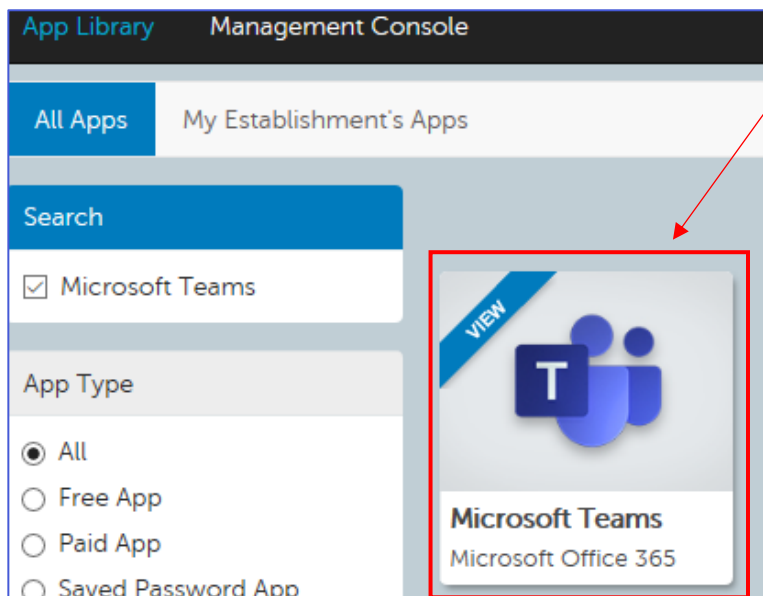
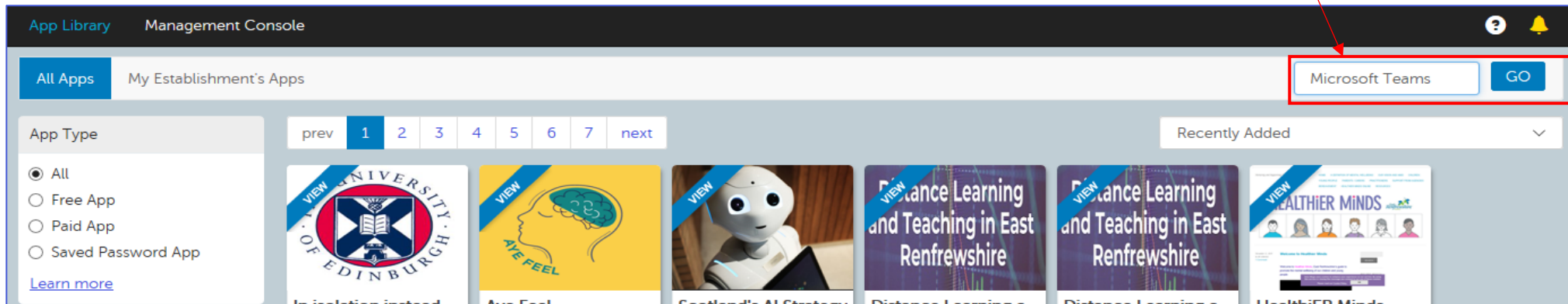


Step Two:

In order to download, the Microsoft Team App, you must click on the 'App Library' tab at the top of the homepage. This will take you onto the page shown below.

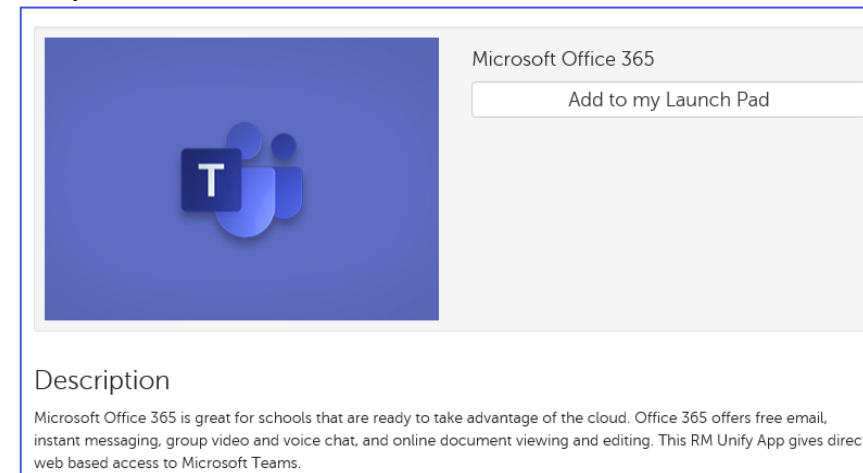


You must search for the Microsoft Teams app in the top right-hand search box, as shown below.

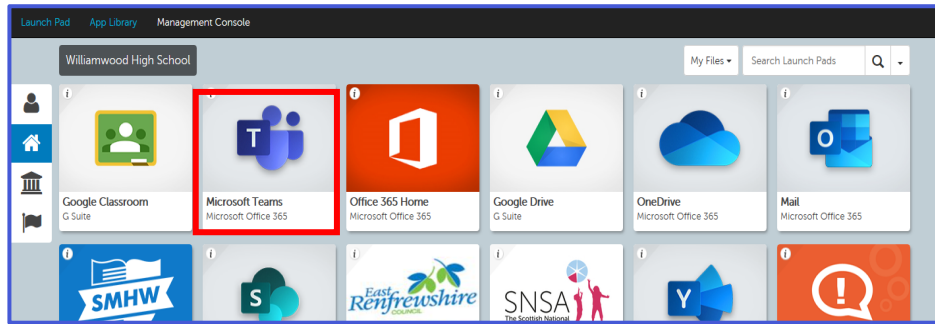


The App should then appear. Click on it and then it will prompt you to add it to your launch pad.

The app will automatically appear when you return to your Launch Pad following these steps.



Step Three:



To access Microsoft Teams, you must click on the App.

If you haven't accessed the app before, you will be met by this message shown below.

In the event of this happening on a Windows device, **please click the link underneath the 'Get the Windows App'.**

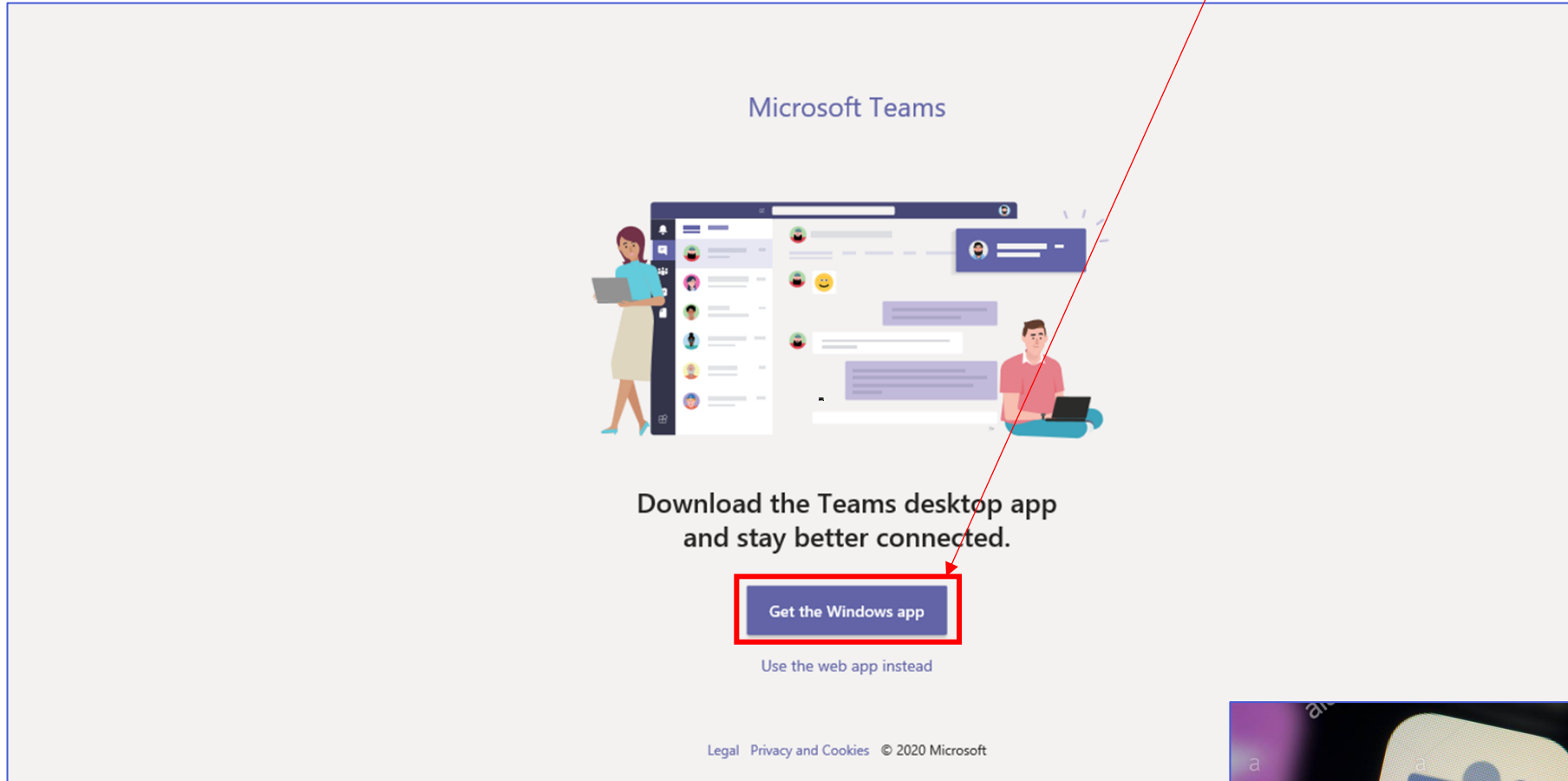

Step Three:

If you have an **Apple device** or are using **Safari** instead of Internet **Explorer/Google Chrome**, you will have to download the app, as you will not be able to access Microsoft Teams without it.

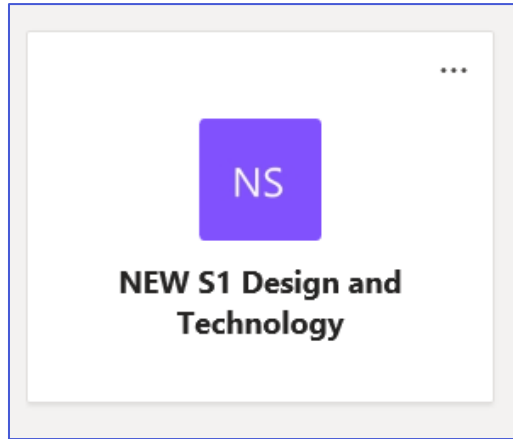


Once you have clicked the appropriate button, you will be taken straight to the Microsoft Teams pages. You should never have to separately log into a Microsoft account or anything. Glow logs you on automatically.

If you wish to access Microsoft Teams via the app on your phone, you must successfully log into the app via Glow before it allows access via the mobile app.



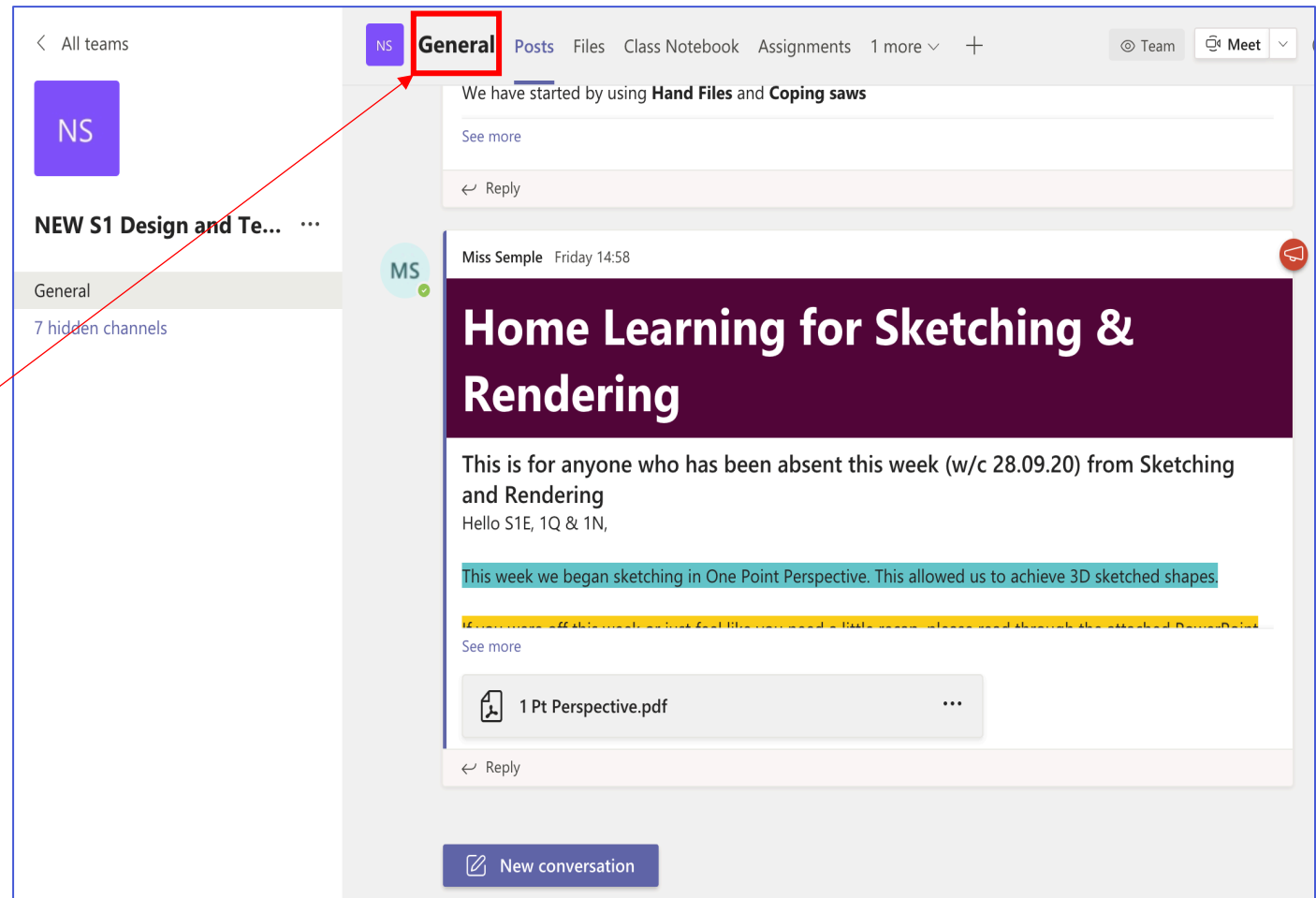
Step Four:



Once you have clicked onto the page, you should be able to see this page shown opposite. This is the **General** page where teachers will post about **Homework** and will post **Home Learning Tasks every week**.

This is the tile you should see in front of you when **Microsoft Teams** opens. You probably will only have one tile, so it should be easy to find.

Click on the tile to access the Teams page.



Step Seven:

In order to access and submit Home Learning materials, you must go onto the General tab.

All Home Learning will appear in this tab, not in the Assignment tab.

More often than not you will have to expand the view of the **Home Learning** post to see all instructions and any corresponding files.

To expand Home Learning task posts, you simply click on the 'See more' button. This will open the tab up so that you can see all information.

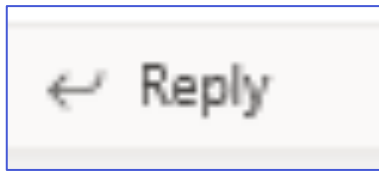

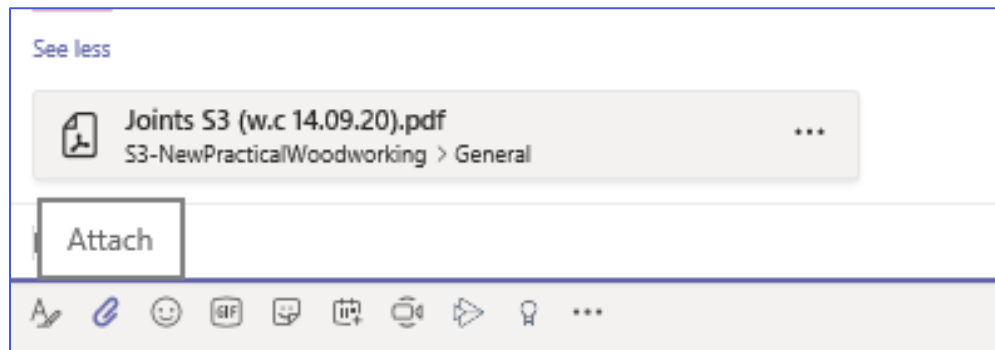
Step Seven:

When submitting work for **Home Learning**, you can choose to either submit it directly onto the **General feed** under the **Home Learning** work that was originally assigned.

This is a quick way to do it, however, it means that all members of the team can access this work, including other pupils.



Simply click the '**Reply**' button and then the '**Attach**' paperclip to add any files.



In the situation where you may not wish others to access your work, you can attach it to an email via Glow and email it directly to your teacher.
