Identity: How do we want to be identified?

The general consensus was creating a brand was important to fostering a sense of identity. How do we do that?

We can start with the following: A banner per house, consisting of:

- Name
- Colour (Tartan equally popular)
- Shared logo of tree with name below the roots

The banner should be displayed in multiple locations, however a large display in the street area on the bannisters bordering the S6 Café.



Identity: How do we want to be identified?

Despite recognising the importance of creating a House brand, the young people were overwhelmingly in favour of all House logos sharing the tree with the Houses coming together to make the tree.

They found the idea of "the houses make the school rather than the school makes the pupils", considerably more attractive

Pupils highlighted an excitement for the sense of belonging and stretching away from just associating with their own year group.





House Structure: Leadership & Responsibilities

The house group structure aims to provide more leadership and responsibility for pupils across all year groups. Pupils favoured this suggested structure and really expressed the liking for all staff across the school being affiliated with a house group.

Pupils favoured the idea to help department deputes through recognising achievement and departmental events.

From this, pupils voiced their liking for the new leadership photos in the street and would like a noticeboards or area for each house leadership team to be displayed on and responsible for.

House Structure: CSS

Due to all pupils within the CSS department falling under the one case load it provides limitations from mixing with those in mainstream houses out with those who attend timetabled classes.

Therefore, after the pupil consultation pupils expressed there liking for the house group system.

Our idea for the CSS department is pupils will be separated across mainstream houses. However, depending on events pupils will be offered an internal departmental option for those who do not wish to attend mainstream activities due to additional support needs. This enables options for all and has recognised and catered for all pupils within the CSS department.











House Events



To create a link between the house system and whole school community pupils favoured the idea of a merit / demerit policy to promote positive behaviour and recognise achievement.

Pupils would like house group information such as points, events, assembly times, logos and achievements to be displayed on the TVs in the street area.



As a house group we would like to expand in gathering more pupil voice surrounding what events would be implemented, after speaking informally to variety of pupils, pupils would like;

- Competitions involving pupils across S1-S6 instead of junior vs senior
- Interdisplinary events involving numerous departments for each house
