W Group Pupil Voice:


Pupils thought 4 house groups would be better with 2 pupil support teachers heading each house.

Pupils thought trees was not relatable to pupils at Williamwood but stated that it would look good for outsiders looking in to the school.


Pupils suggested the following ideas:

W Group Pupil Voice:




Pupils thought having a colour related to each house group would be the best way to identify the houses.
