

As you will be aware, pupils at Williamwood attend classes in "columns". For example, S3 pupils attend their column C class on a Tuesday period 7. So at that time there will be 5 classes at French, 1 class at Geography, 2 at History and 3 at Modern Studies as detailed opposite.

Since our S3 pupils sit their exams in classes, the exam timetable has to be based on this column structure.

With this in mind, the section of the schematic below shows us that on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> April pupils **could** have a column D exam during period 2 and a column C exam during period 5.

Not all subjects will necessarily use all of the periods allocated to them in the exam timetable. For example, there are three column C times on the timetable in total. French might plan to use two of these times but Geography may only use one.
