The Curricular Choice Process

- Broad General Education experience all curriculum areas up to third or fourth level
- Options allow personalisation and choice
- Reduce number of courses to deepen learning
- S3 Transition from BGE to National Qualifications
- Prepare pupils to complete up to 10 Nationals in S4 across all curricular areas

S3 – continue to study elements from 8 key curricular areas:

S3 Curriculum overview

- 3 Periods of study in most subjects; English & Maths 4/5
- Introduced 3 Sciences, 2 Languages and a range of new choices
- Religious and Moral Education Core or N5
- Physical Education Core, N5 or Both
- PSHE 1 period each week
- Vocational Training to be available for some pupils in S4 and occasionally some S3 pupils


