High School

School leavers from S4-S6. You can leave school from the age of 16. You can leave with a range of different qualifications and experiences. You can also take part in college courses and flexible work placements whilst studying.



Employment

School leavers can go straight into the work environment, developing their skills and experiences on the job whilst getting paid. Some employers may put you through college or university to gain qualifications whilst in employment.



College

You can study a range of full time and part time college courses, in a range of different subjects. You can study at different levels which suit you, HNC, HND and more. A HND will get you into 3rd year at a related university course.



Distance Learning

Distance learning allows you to gain a qualification in a subject area of your choice from the comfort of your own home. This allows you to gain a qualification which can be used to gain entry to university and college. This can be done whilst working full/part time.



Apprenticeships

You can study for an Apprenticeship whilst still at school or full time. Studying an Apprenticeship allows you to learn skills and gain a qualification on the job whilst getting paid.
